THE SECOND EPISTLE OF PAUL THE APOSTLE TO THE

THESSALONIANS

CHAPTER I

PAUL, and Sil-va'-nus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessa-a-lo'-ni-ans in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

2 Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

3 We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the

7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.

8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming.

9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:

12 That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

14 Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.

16 Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,

17 Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

CHAPTER 3

FINALLY, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be

lation to them that trouble you;

7 And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels,

8 In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:

9 Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

10 When he shall come to be glorified (in) his saints, and to be admired (in) all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.

11 Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power:

12 That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye (in) him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

CHAPTER 2

NOW we beseech you, brethren, (by) the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,

2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

5 Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?

6 And now ye know what

2 And that we may be delivered from **unreasonable and wicked men**: for all *men* have not faith.

3 But the Lord is **faithful**, who shall **stablish** you, and keep *you* from evil.

4 And we have confidence in the Lord **touching** you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you.

5 And the Lord direct your hearts into the **love** of God, and into the patient **waiting for Christ**.

6 Now we command you, brethren, in the **name** of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye **withdraw yourselves from every brother** that walketh disorderly, and not after the **tradition which he** received of us.

7 For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we **behaved** not ourselves disorderly among you;

8 Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that we might not be chargeable to any of you:

9 Not because we have not **power**, but to make ourselves an **ensample** unto you to follow us.

THE FIRST EPISTLE OF PAUL THE APOSTLE
TO

TIMOTHY

CHAPTER 1

PAUL, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our **Saviour**, and Lord Jesus Christ, *which is* our **hope**;

2 Unto Timothy, *my* own son in the faith: **Grace, mercy, and peace**, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

3 As I besought thee to abide still at Eph'-e-sus, when I went into Mac-e-do'-ni-a, that thou

mightest charge some that they **teach no other doctrine**,

4 Neither give heed to **fables** and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly **edifying** which is in faith: *so do*.

5 Now the end of the commandment is **charity** out of a **pure heart**, and *of* a good conscience, and *of* faith unfeigned:

6 From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling;
